hen we reflect on 2020 as members of the community, many emotions come to mind: fear, stress, frustration and uncertainty. But when we think of the year in terms of what we were able to accomplish at The Village Network, we think of something different: our core values of Fostering Creativity, Innovation, Agility and Continuous Improvement in action.

Throughout this tumultuous year, The Village Network team has recognized that the children and families we serve need us more now than ever. That's why we've been creative, agile and innovative in our approach to care, always working to ensure that we can meet their mental health needs. With our innovative approach, we were able to provide care for over 6,680 youth in our outpatient, residential and treatment foster care programs across the state of Ohio and in Northern West Virginia.

We invite you to reflect with us on our 2020 milestones and celebrate the agility of our people, programs, and the new ways we found to create brighter futures.

Highlights include:

- Quickly pivoting to a telehealth platform to ensure counseling services could continue for the youth we were already serving when Ohio went on lockdown this spring;
- Rolling out new technology to enable staff to more effectively collaborate from remote locations and provide anywhere/anytime services to youth;
- Implementing health precautions to keep youth, families and staff safe on our residential campuses and at our outpatient facilities;
- Extending our telehealth counseling services to the community and frontline healthcare workers;
- Providing mental health tips and videos on social media to help our friends and neighbors with their mental health needs during this unprecedented health crisis;
- Advancing the Neurosequential Model of Therapeutics and the Collaborative Problem Solving approach through education and training sessions provided to clinicians and staff across the state;
- Partnering with agencies in Southeast Ohio to serve 246 children with early childhood mental health services;
- Expanding school-based services for the greater Dayton community with a new partnership with Montgomery County Educational Service Center;
- Reducing employee turnover and making strides in our goal to make TVN the best place to work with a strong focus on collaboration.

Although the COVID-19 pandemic has already served up some mean curveballs, we know our work related to this health crisis is far from over. While the numbers of reported child abuse cases have declined over the past year, experts anticipate that as the protective measures from COVID-19 are lifted and children return to their physical schools and community programs, there will be a surge in demand for foster care and mental health services.

As we prepare for this influx, we'll continue to focus on our ability to develop creative and innovative solutions, which has enabled us to compassionately support the behavioral, physical and emotional health of children and families since 1946.

And as we move forward during this unprecedented time, we can't thank you enough for your continued dedication and support in empowering youth and families to build brighter futures.






Average Length of Stay




