Growing with 'CARE'

TVN's Care Management Region was established in 2022 when we signed on as a Care Management Entity (CME) through a partnership with the Aetna OhioRISE program, marking an important step forward in coordinated care for children and families across Western Franklin County. Since its inception, TVN OhioRISE has provided comprehensive behavioral health care coordination for more than 1,500 children each day, ensuring that young people with complex behavioral health needs receive the individualized attention and support they deserve.

In addition, we contracted with Franklin County Children's Services to provide case management under the name TVN Family Services with a commitment to strengthening families by delivering high-quality child welfare casework services to over 150 families daily. These services are centered on promoting the core principles of child welfare—safety, permanency, and well-being—while empowering families to build stability and resilience within their communities.

Over the past three years, the Care Management Region has experienced remarkable growth, expanding to a dedicated team of more than 120 professionals. Each staff member plays an essential role in advancing the organization's mission of connecting families to vital community resources and supports. Together, they strive to promote safety, enhance mental health outcomes, and foster overall wellness for children and families throughout the region. Through collaboration, compassion, and a shared vision of stronger, healthier communities, the Care Management Region continues to make a lasting impact on the lives of those it serves.




Age




Average Length of Stay




